

Responding to the community

- "Fix the sidewalks, roads, and drains, because it hurts the community. When it rains the whole area, the roads, the sidewalks, they flood for days, but walk two minutes down the street and that would never happen. Why the difference."
- "We've lived in Stamford for almost 25 years now, and the City has never repaired or repaved our road, even though its crumbling."
- "The streets with the most visibility always get taken care of, but the streets off to the side get no love. How can one street be clean and smooth, and the one next to it be dirty"

Objectives

- 1. Develop a two-tier paving schedule for FY22-23
- 2. Develop 5-year comprehensive sidewalk restoration plan Stamford public schools
- 3. Launch comprehensive city-wide roadway assessment to establish priority paving list for FY23-FY27
- 4. Research the opportunity to integrate unaccepted roads into the city's future road paving plan





Objective 1:

Develop a two-tier paving schedule that will identify and target 70 roads and over 20 miles for paving during the 2022 season.

- a. The Tier 1 paving list is on the city's website (43 roads)
- b. The Operations Department is compiling the Tier 2 list, projecting 27 30 additional roads to target
- c. Representatives and constituents can submit requests for road and street consideration through FIX It Stamford





Objective 2:

Develop comprehensive sidewalk restoration plan restoring 100% of Stamford's public schools in 5 years (5 schools year 1)

- c. Northeast
- d. Springdale
- e. Julia A. Stark





Objective 3:

Launch comprehensive city-wide roadway assessment to establish priority paving list for FY23-FY27.






