




# Bowstring Truss Bridge











### Detour Plan





#### **Cross Section**



- Abutments are landward of Tidal Wetlands, C.G.L. and high tide.
- Bridge has a clear span of 142 feet. With no piers in the water.
- The engineer of record has stated, "The hydraulic analyses indicate that for the 100-year flow rate, the water surface profile for the proposed condition will have 0.0 foot increase, in comparison to existing conditions.
