Rep. Zelinsky asked why there was a refund of only \$25 for people who were not home to use any water.

Mr. Brink explained that there is a user charge of \$5 per CCF. People can only get a \$30 refund if they paid the \$30 minimum charge. If they paid nothing, or less or owed the

WPCA money, or if they used 1 ccf of water, they would get a \$25 refund. Without seeing the specific bills, he cannot address particular concerns. A customer who disputes their water consumption use can call the customer service number to have this investigated. The determination of water usage is based upon Aquarion meter readings.
