As the rinks software cannot track resident , non resident users I took a little time to manually obtain the following figures and made two handouts with the rinks schedule as an example of the ice usage at Terry Conners Rink. Some further information. The rinks time is broken into prime time (3:30pm to 9:30pm weekday's and 7:00am to 9:00 pm weekends) and non prime time (all hours not listed above). We also have seasons , off season is considered April 1st to August 31st , during this time period we lower rates in order to entice ice rentals and hold our successful summer camp and other rink run programs. September 1st to March 31st is what we consider our busy season with youth hockey and synchronized skating seasons beginning (both Stamford groups and our primary ice users) , December 1st high school hockey begins which runs to mid March depending on the success of the local teams (the SHS/WHS co-op boys team won the Division 3 state championship in 2016).

The bottom line is that resident groups use approximately 80/85 % of prime time ice during our busy season, rink run programs 10/12 % and non resident groups the remaining roughly 5/8 %.
