City of Stamford Charter, Sec. C5-40-2(b)

#### **Regular Police**

- Citywide Law Enforcement
- Prioritized by severity of incident
- Focused on most serious issues
  - Violent Crime
  - Gang Activity
  - Other Threats to Public Safety
- Most parks issues are low-priority
  - Response dependent on availability
  - Limited time for low-priority issues
  - Not specifically trained in Park Regs

### Same Police Powers Different Priorities

#### **Park Police**

- Focused on Law Enforcement in Parks
- Prioritize Quality of Life issues
- Trained in Park Regulations
- Proactive presence
- Complaints involving parks receive immediate, focused response
- Emphasize "soft" enforcement
  - Most citizen encounters are advisory
  - BUT: Can take immediate police action when needed (cite/arrest etc.)
