PARK POLICE OFFICER

(Permanent Part-Time)

The City of Stamford, Office of Operations is accepting applications for a permanent part-time Park Police Officer.

Under the general direction of the Manager of Parks & Facilities for administrative purposes, and under the general supervision of a superior police officer while performing uniformed or investigative duties, patrols City parks and other property under the City of Stamford jurisdiction for the purpose of assisting the public, controlling crime, preventing or detecting violations of law, and making arrests; performs related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Explains and interprets applicable state statutes, park ordinances, rules and regulations. Patrols parks and other jurisdictional facilities for the purpose of controlling crime, preventing and detecting violations of laws, and making arrests or issuing citations for violations on foot and by vehicle. Provides crowd and traffic control coverage at special events. Responds to emergencies at park locations. Drives a City vehicle to travel to various park locations, and respond to emergency situations. Performs other similar and related duties as required.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Traverse difficult terrain, strength and stamina to physically restrain suspects; vision to read printed materials and a computer screen; and hearing and speech to communicate in person or over the telephone.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: At time of appointment, possession of a valid motor vehicle operator's license and valid Connecticut Police Officer Standards & Training ("POST") certification which must be continuously maintained as a condition of continued employment. Applicant must obtain appointment as a Stamford Special Police Officer and maintain such appointment in good standing as a condition of continued employment.
