Dear Mayor Martin,

We are writing to ask you to maintain our Park Police and their current relationship to Parks Operations. Over the last two weeks, **one thousand and fifty-nine (1059) individuals who value our parks, have signed our online (686) and hardcopy (373) petitions* to Save Our Park Police** (see attachments for online signatures/hardcopy petition signatures will be hand delivered). Park Police have a unique set of priorities that enhances public safety and quality of life in our parks. The Stamford Police Department does an admirable job making our city safe, however, the Park Police are the secret ingredient that make a person feel safe in our parks. Parks Regulations are simply not something the Stamford Police Department can give the same degree of attention to.

Here are few recent events that we are aware of that illustrate this need:

- Homeless encampments and alcohol related deaths;
- Loud noise, speeding, unpermitted vehicles and unpermitted field use;
- Lione and Carwin Parks are very good examples of Parks that are covered by SPD. SPD now wants Park Police stationed there to correct the bad habits that have developed over time. Should this be done at the expense of the Parks where Park Police have prevented this from happening?

Mayor Martin, please eliminate the uncertainty surrounding our Park Police by authorizing the reappointment of the two officers we have. Commit your Administration to the expansion of the Park Police force to work in the same joint relationship with Parks/Operations and SPD that has served this City so well for over 50+ years.
