## RESOLUTION NO. 3973 PERMITTING SIGNAGE BY DESIGNATED YOUTH SPORTS LEAGUES

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives supports youth sports activities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives is aware of the need for youth sports organizations to be able to raise funds for its activities via the sale of advertising banners on outfield fences; and

WHEREAS, Section 65-4 of the Code of Ordinances prevents advertising in Stamford's parks, unless prior approval for such advertising is obtained by the Board of Representatives.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 30<sup>H</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES that the following organizations are permitted to place advertising signage or displays, from April 1<sup>st</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup>, on the fences of their designated field(s), limiting signage size and placement to the physical dimensions of the fence on which the signs are applied and facing the inside of the playing field:

Stamford American Little League; Stamford National Little League; Stamford North Little League; Jackie Robinson League; Boys Babe Ruth Baseball; American Legion Baseball; Stamford Girls Babe Ruth Softball; Stamford Youth Soccer; Stamford Youth Foundation Football; and Domus Youth Rugby; Greater Stamford Tennis Association and the Stamford Tennis Academy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE 30<sup>TH</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES that this approval is effective for one year from the date of enactment.

This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
