RESOLUTION NO. 4045 AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2797 CONCERNING NON-RESIDENT BEACH STICKER FEES

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives approved Resolution No. 2740 at its May 6, 2002 regular meeting establishing a Non-Resident Beach Sticker Policy, which resolution was amended by Resolution No. 2753, approved on July 1, 2002 and Resolution No. 2797, approved on March 3, 2003; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to amend the fees charged to non-residents to access City of Stamford beaches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, hereby approves the following policy:

A motor vehicle owned by a non-resident shall be permitted to enter upon or use the facilities of all beaches from the first Saturday in May through the last Sunday in September, inclusive, provided that a parking permit has been purchased and is affixed to the windshield of the vehicle. The rate will be \$275 per season. The rate will be \$40 per day for daily Monday through Friday access and \$65 per day for Saturday and Sunday access.

Non-resident full time or permanent part time employees of the City of Stamford or the Stamford Public Schools who provide proof of current employment shall be eligible for a parking permit at the rate charged to Stamford residents with a car registered in Stamford.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.

This resolution was approved by a Roll Call Vote of 32-4-0 at the Regular Meeting of the 30th Board of Representatives held on Monday, May 4, 2020.
