ORDINANCE NO. 1263 SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 84 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, "BOATS"

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford owns certain boat slips within Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford issues seasonal permits to residents for the use and enjoyment of City owned boat slips; and

WHEREAS, in the past, persons have moored or anchored to City owned boat slips without first obtaining a permit; and

WHEREAS, the Stamford Code of Ordinances does not current contain a provision authorizing the assessment of a fine in such cases.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Chapter 84, Boats, Section 84-10 be added to the Stamford Code as follows:

Sec. 84-10. - Permit required.

- 1. No person shall moor or anchor any vessel, boat or craft to any City owned boat slip without first obtaining a permit issued by the Division of Cashiering and Permitting.
- 2. Any person who violates this provision shall be fined \$100. Each day or part of a day that a violation of this provision occurs shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to a separate \$100 fine.
- 3. This section may be enforced by any City police officer or City civil citation officer.
