ORDINANCE NO. 1267 SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 175, PARKS AND RECREATION, SEC. 175-1, REGARDING DESIGNATION OF ANY CITY PARK OR RECREATIONAL FACILITY AS "PERMIT PARKING ONLY."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Chapter 175. Parks and Recreation, Section 175-1, of the Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

Sec. 175-1. - Adoption of regulations; posting.

Regulations for the use and conduct of all public parks and all of their facilities, and for the use and conduct of all public recreation areas and all of their facilities, which have been or shall be adopted by the Parks and Recreation Commission or the Mill River Collaborative, in the case of the Mill River Park and Greenway, and filed with the Board of Representatives and approved by said Board by resolution shall have the force and effect of law, provided that a copy of said regulations is published at least once in a newspaper having a general circulation in the city. Notwithstanding any provision of the regulations of the Parks and Recreation Commission to the contrary, the designation of any City park or recreational facility as "permit parking only" shall be made by Resolution of the Board of Representatives.
