CONCERNING BEACH AND PARK PASS FEES FOR RESIDENTS

WHEREAS, Section 231-3 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances provides that only a motor vehicle owned by a resident or taxpayer of the city shall be permitted to enter upon or use the facilities of any public park or beach of the city, except in accordance with such regulations as are adopted by the Parks and Recreation Commission and approved by resolution of the Board of Representatives, and

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Committee of the Board of Representatives considered the matter of adjustments to the fees charged to Stamford residents for parking permits for City beaches and parks at its _____, 2021 meeting;

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Committee held a public hearing on _____, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has found that eliminating the fees charged to Stamford residents for parking permits for City beaches and parks would be in the best interests of its citizens as it would encourage the use of Stamford beaches and parks by Stamford residents and reduce the financial burden for using City facilities on Stamford taxpayers; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Representatives of Stamford, pursuant to and within the limitations of Section C2-10-2(6) of the Charter of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the following fee schedule for residents of the City of Stamford, with non-commercial vehicles, who are current on their respective car tax obligations:

Category	Current Fee	New Fee
Resident Registered Car	\$25.00	\$0.00
Resident Non-Registered Car	\$110.00	\$110.00
Resident Registered Car – Senior	\$7.00	\$0.00
Resident Non-Registered Car – Senior	\$35.00	\$35.00
Summer Resident	\$125.00	\$125.00

The resolution will take effect starting in the 2023 beach season, to allow for the Mayor's Office to budget for, and the Department of Operations to plan for, the new fee schedule.
