NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 30<sup>H</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES that the following organizations are permitted to place advertising signage or displays within the confines or boundaries of their designated field(s) and or playing surface areas, from April 1<sup>st</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup>, on the fences of their designated field(s), with the exception that no advertising signage may be placed on the soccer fields at West Beach:
