ORDINANCE NO. 1237 SUPPLEMENTAL DESIGNATING THE POSITION OF **BUILDING OFFICIAL AS UNCLASSIFIED**

ARTICLE L. – BUILDING OFFICIAL

Sec. 40-176 - Designation of position of Building Official as unclassified position.

The position of Building Official, created by Sec. C5-30-6 of the Charter of the City of Stamford and by Sec. 29-260 of the State of Connecticut General Statutes, is designated as an unclassified position in accordance with Sec. C5-20-15(g) of the Charter of the City of Stamford.

The ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
