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



Good afternoon Your Honor,

Attached is a proposed Contract CorVel Enterprise Claims for RFP 2026.0069 Worker's

Compensation and Heart & Hypertension Claims Administration. If agreeable, ***please print the signature page in color, sign/date in blue before two witnesses, scan it in color and email it back to me for further processing.***

CorVel will provide worker's compensation services in the following areas: claims administration services, medical management through the utilization of a preferred provider organization and administration of heart and hypertension for the City's Police Department and Fire Department. These services will commence on January 1, 2026, and terminate three (3) years thereafter. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the Term of this Agreement for two (2) additional years provided that all other terms of this Agreement remain the same. No such extension shall be for greater than one (1) year and, under no circumstances, shall the entire Term of this Agreement, including any extension years, exceed five (5) years.

The fees for these services will be paid yearly as outlined in the Compensation section of the Contract (paragraph 3) and in CorVel's Price Proposal attached thereto as Exhibit C. The yearly rate for the first year of services is Three Hundred twenty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Forty (\$326,740.00) Dollars.

However, this Contract has a \$99,000.00 cap on fees without an additional notice to proceed from the City, which notice to proceed is subject to Board approvals. This allows CorVel to continue these necessary services while we seek Board approvals for payment over \$100,000.00. I will, therefore, forward the full set of fully executed Contract documents back to you with instructions to submit them to the Board of Finance and Board of Representatives for approval.
