Mr. Williams explained that

- the contract has been amended to remove the language regarding the residency requirement and other language cleanups
- the position is in the Pay Plan at Level 7, Step 2, which is approximately \$141,000
- If the position were being filled by a physician, the ordinance permits a 50%

- salary increase and the position would be at Step 4, resulting in a salary of \$225,000
- The City must have a medical doctor on staff to supervise various nurses. This
 role is filled by Dr. Yoon. Dr. Yoon is paid \$3,500 per month as a consultant, so
 the City is saving \$41,000 by having him as the medical doctor
- State law requires Stamford to have a medical director and requires the medical director to have a MPH degree.

A motion to approve this agreement was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 8-0-0 (Reps. Nabel, Fedeli, DePina, Figueroa, McMullen, Miller, Okun and Savage in favor).

Chair Nabel adjourned the meeting at 5:43 p.m.
