RESOLUTION NO. 3764 CONCERNING FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE AND SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, the administrative costs of issuing licenses to food service establishments and fees for services have significantly increased; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to increase the fee for food service establishment licenses and service fees to cover the higher costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 29th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, pursuant to Chapter 132, Article III of the Code of Ordinances, does hereby approve the following fee schedules:


