SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 148, HOUSING STANDARDS, ARTICLE III, BLIGHTED PROPERTIES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

This ordinance amends Chapter 146 of the Code of Ordinances to 1) require that refuse and recycling containers be removed from the street or curb within two days following collection rather than by 9 a.m. the following day; and 2) eliminate the requirement that the Board of Representatives approve the members of the Blight Hearing Committee.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
