## SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 179, PEDDLERS, STREET VENDORS AND SOLICITORS TO ADD ARTICLE IV, MOBILE STREET VENDORS

This ordinance adds a new Article IV, Mobile Street Vendors, to Chapter 179, Peddlers, Street Vendors and Solicitors of the Code of Ordinances to regulate mobile food vendors in the City of Stamford. The ordinance 1) requires each mobile food vendor to obtain a permit from the City of Stamford Food Truck Committee ("Food Truck Committee") prior to vending on a public street in the City of Stamford; 2) creates a Food Truck Committee to administer the permit process and authorizes the Food Truck Committee to create regulations in connection with the administration of this article; 3) sets forth the procedures for obtaining a mobile vending permit from the Food Truck Committee and the fees to be charged for such permit; 4) sets forth provisions under which the Food Truck Committee may deny Issuance of a mobile vending permit or revoke such a permit; and 5) restricts the hours and location of vending by mobile food vendors and regulates the operations of such vendors. The ordinance further provides a penalty of \$200 for each violation of this article, and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
