RESOLUTION NO. 3931 SETTING FEES FOR MISCELLANEOUS HEALTH INSPECTIONS AND TESTING

WHEREAS, Chapter Sec. 143 of the Code of Ordinances provides for an administrative fee for miscellaneous health inspections and testing; and

WHEREAS, Section 143-13 of the Code of Ordinances provides that said fees shall be set by Resolution of the Board of Representatives.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2596, the Board of Representatives approved fees for miscellaneous health inspections and tests on July 5, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the inspections and testing performed by the Health Department have changed and the administrative costs of performing miscellaneous health inspections and testing has significantly increased; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to delete some fees and increase other fees for miscellaneous health inspections and testing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 30th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, pursuant to Sec. 143-13 of the Code of Ordinances, does hereby approve the following fee Schedule:
