ORDINANCE NUMBER 1249 SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER § 141-3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETICIANS, SECTION 141-3 – PLAN REVIEW AND PREOPERATION INSPECTION

WHEREAS, Chapter § 141of the Code of Ordinances contains provisions concerning safeguarding the health and well-being of persons who patronize barbershops and hairdressing and cosmetology shops; and

WHEREAS, Section 141-3 of the Code of Ordinances requires the Director of Health or such Director's agent to conduct a preoperational inspection of any barbershop or hairdressing or cosmetology shop; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Code of Ordinances, Section 141-3 should be amended to provide for the addition of fees for such preoperational inspection by the Health Department; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a more efficient and effective manner of setting such fees would be by Resolution of the Board of Representatives as it may determine the need, from time to time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Section § 141-3 the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 141-3. - Plan review and preoperation inspection.

- Whenever a barbershop or hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop having a permanent location is relocated, constructed, remodeled or extensively altered and whenever an existing structure is converted to use as a barbershop or hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop, properly prepared plans and specifications for such construction, remodeling or alteration shall be submitted to the Director or his agent for review and approval before relocation, construction, remodeling or alteration is begun. The plans and specifications shall indicate the proposed layout, arrangement and construction materials of work areas and the type and model of proposed fixed equipment and facilities. The Director shall approve the plans and specifications if they meet the requirements of this chapter and the Public Health Code of the State of Connecticut. Prior to the barbershop's or hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop's opening, the Director or his such Director's agent shall conduct a preoperational inspection to determine compliance with the approved plans and specifications and with the requirements of this chapter and the Public Health Code of the State of Connecticut.
- B. Fees may be imposed under this section as may be deemed necessary for the health and well-being of the citizens of the City of Stamford. The applicable fees shall be set by Resolution of the Board of Representatives.
