SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE REGARDING GHOST GUNS

REGARDING GHOST GUNS

This proposed ordinance amends Chapter 242 of the Code of Ordinances, Weapons, to add a new section, 242-4, "3-D Printed Firearms Made of Polymer Plastic and any Other Firearms not Permanently Affixed with Unique Serial Numbers or Identification Marks ("Ghost Guns Prohibited")". This proposed ordinance 1) prohibits the assembly, storage, sale or possession of any firearm (including 3-D printed firearms) in the City of Stamford that does not have a unique serial number or appropriate mark of identification and that is not permanently affixed with such serial number or other identifying mark in a manner that conforms with the requirements imposed on licensed importers and licensed manufacturers of firearms pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 923(i); and 2) prohibits the assembly, storage, sale or possession of any firearm (Including 3-D printed firearms) in the City of Stamford that is made of polymer plastic, unless such plastic is imbedded with three point seven (3.7) cunces of material 17-4 PH stainless steel and such firearm is engraved or otherwise marked with a unique serial number or other mark of identification. The ordinance further authorizes the Chief of Police to seize, remove and destroy any such weapons within the City of Stamford and to impose a fine or penalty of \$250 per day of violation, or the maximum amount permitted by law, whichever is greater. The ordinance further provides that the owner of such weapon may appeal the seizure of said weapon pursuant to Chapter 97 of the Code of Ordinances.
