**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 171 OIL AND GAS DRILLING,
ARTICLE I. - PROHIBITION OF WASTES GENERATED FROM
OIL AND GAS DRILLING AND EXTRACTION ACTIVITIES**

This ordinance amends Chapter 171 Oil and Gas Drilling, Article I. - Prohibition of Wastes Generated from Oil and Gas Drilling and Extraction Activities, Section 171-4 - Provision to be included in bids and contracts related to the construction or maintenance of publicly owned and/or maintained roads or real property within the City of the Code of Ordinances by adding the phrase "to the best of our knowledge and after diligent inquiry," to the statement required in all bids related to the purchase or acquisition of materials to be used to construct or maintain any publicly owned and/or maintained road or real property within the City and all bids related to the retention of services to construct or maintain any publicly owned and/or maintained road or real property within the City.
