SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. _____ SUPPLEMENTAL
AMENDING CHAPTER 179, PEDDLERS, STREET VENDORS AND
SOLICITORS
ARTICLE IV, MOBILE STREET VENDORS TO
REMOVE THE FOOD TRUCK COMMITTEE FROM
THE PERMITTING PROCESS

This Ordinance adds Chapter 179, Peddlers, Street Vendors and Solicitors, Article IV, Mobile Street Vendors, of the Code of Ordinances creating a Stamford Appointments Commission to change the application process for Mobile Vending Permits so that applications for mobile vending permits, as well as permits for vending in city parks, are considered, issued and enforced by the Cashiering and Permitting Department rather than the Food Truck Committee
