ORDINANCE NO. ____ SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 72 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, §72-2 - SALE AND CONSUMPTION ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Chapter 72, Section 72-2 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances, Alcoholic Beverages, be amended as follows:

Sec. 72-2. Sale and consumption on municipal property.

No intoxicating liquor, except beer, shall be sold or consumed on any municipally owned property, and no intoxicating liquor whatsoever shall be sold or consumed on any city street or in any vehicle upon city streets. An exception to this section may be granted by the governing body.

A. Except as permitted in section C hereof, no person shall consume any *alcoholic liquor*, or possess any open container of *alcoholic liquor* upon or within the limits of any public highway or municipally owned public area within the City of Stamford. For purposes of this section, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the consumption of *alcoholic liquor* or the possession of an open container of *alcoholic liquor* in parked vehicles within or upon a public highway or municipally owned public area is a violation hereof.

B. No person shall consume any *alcoholic liquor* or possess any o 29 pen container of *alcoholic liquor* in any building or room maintained for the sale, distribution, or dispensing of *alcoholic liquor* s that does not possess a license or permit issued by the department of *liquor* control for the said same sale, distribution, or dispensing of *alcoholic liquors* if said same sale, distribution or dispensing of *alcoholic liquors* if said same sale, distribution or dispensing of said *alcoholic liquors* is in violation of Chapter 30 of the general statutes of the State of Connecticut.

C. Exceptions:

(1) Consumption of *alcoholic liquor* and possession of an open container of *alcoholic liquor* is permitted during any function, festival, event or celebration conducted on or within a public highway or municipally owned public area pursuant to any federal code, Connecticut State Statute, City of Stamford Ordinance, City of Stamford Resolution or Permit authorizing sale and consumption of *liquor* in or upon such public highway or municipally owned public area.

(2) Consumption of beer, in non-glass containers, shall be permitted in all City of Stamford Parks that contain sporting event fields and/or beaches in accordance with the regulations adopted pursuant to City of Stamford Ordinance 175-1.

<u>D. Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be fined one hundred dollars</u> (\$100) for each offense.
