SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL
AMENDING CHAPTER 242 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ADDING
SECTION 242-5 PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS AND
EXPLOSIVES IN GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS AND POLLING PLACES

This proposed ordinance amends Chater 242 of the Code of Ordinances, Weapons, to add a new Section 242-5 prohibiting the possession of explosives and firearms in any building or portion thereof, including its grounds, that is owned, leased, or controlled by the City of Stamford and within 500 feet of any polling place or ballot drop box within the City of Stamford on the day of an election or during the time when voting is permitted for any election or at a place officially designated for the counting of ballots on any day when ballots are being counted or conducting activities related to a federal, state, or municipal election. Notice of these prohibitions must be posted conspicuously at all public entrances to the locations where the prohibition is applicable.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the prohibitions in this ordinance do not apply to a) any federal, state, or local law enforcement officer when engaged in official duties, (b) any member of the United States Armed Forces or Connecticut National Guard when engaged in official duties; (c) private security guards acting in the course of their duties and with appropriate permits; (d) the carrying, possession, or lawful storage of a firearm inside a motor vehicle; or (e) Any retired law enforcement officer in good standing. A person violating these prohibitions shall be required to immediately leave the premises and may be subject to additional criminal penalties including, but not limited to, criminal trespass for failure to do so. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not exceeding \$250.00.
