**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL
CONCERNING ELECTIONS - BOUNDARIES OF MUNICIPAL VOTING
DISTRICTS**

This proposed ordinance amends the municipal voting district boundaries for the City of Stamford as presented in the March 29, 2022 report of the Redistricting Commission as subsequently amended at the April 6, 2022 meeting of the Special Redistricting Committee; the map of the districts and the written street descriptions of the new boundaries are attached thereto. In the event that any future scrivener's errors in the street descriptions are subsequently discovered that do not materially affect voting districts, the Board of Representatives is authorized to correct such error(s) by resolution.
