NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Representa-tives of the City of Stamford requests from the Connecticut General As-sembly the right to establish vehicle safety, vehicle operation and general service standards above those established by the Department of Trans-portation of the State of Connecticut.

BE IT FURTHER, RESOLVED that should the aforementioned right not be made available, the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford requests that the Connecticut General Assembly establish a regional Taxicab and Livery Service Commission to license, further regulate, and enforce regulations pertaining to taxicab and livery services operating in the City of Stamford.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the aforementioned rights not be made available, the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford requests that existing standards and regulations be enforced by the appropriate authority and that standards for taxicab and livery companies operating in the City of Stamford be established that include, but are not limited to:

Availability of a significant number of Handicap Accessible taxicabs;
 Acceptance of credit and debit cards by all taxicabs and mandated avail-

ability to passengers;

•Cessation of smoking by drivers whilst operating a taxicab or livery servers.

Non-possession by taxicab or livery service drivers of weapons of any

type unless otherwise allowed by law;

•Acceptance of Share the Fare vouchers by all taxicabs operating at designated taxicab stands. 285-58-2-1015
