SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE CREATING A STAMFORD ARTS AND CULTURE COMMISSION

This ordinance adds a new Article to the City of Stamford Code of Ordinances creating a Stamford Arts & Culture Commission. The ordinance provides that the Commission shall consist of 9 members, including six members active in the City's cultural community and three residents of the City of Stamford as well as four ex officio members. The purpose of the Commission shall be to work with arts and cultural organizations in the Commission shall be to work with arts and cultural organizations in the City to encourage the development of the creative, performing, and visual arts as well as cultural activities in the City of Stamford; to serve as an arts as well as cultural activities in the City for activities in the arts; and information center and focal point in the City for activities in the arts; and to assist the City in the care, maintenance and preservation of the City's art collection and possible acquisition of new art.
