## SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 214, ARTICLE V, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, OUTDOOR DINING, TO EXPAND OUTDOOR DINING INTO PARKING SPACES AND THE ROADWAY

This proposed ordinance amends Chapter 214, Article V, of the Code of Ordinances, Outdoor Dining to:

- permit a Food Service Establishment to use public property, including portions of a sidewalk, roadway, and parking spaces as an Outdoor Dining Area during certain months of the year;
- clarify the processes for permit applications and review for Outdoor Dining on Public Property and in the Public Right-of-Way;
- change the fee schedule for the license per year for Outdoor Dining areas which utilize the Public Right-of-Way beginning January 1, 2023 based upon the number of seats in the public right of way as follows:

Level 1 20 seats or fewer \$250.00

Level 2 21-45 Seats \$500.00

Level 3 Greater than 45 seats \$1,500.00

with fees increasing every 2 years through January 1, 2027, and specifying that the fee for any Outdoor Dining Area which includes a metered parking space shall be charged a fee equal to Level 3, regardless of the number of seats in the Public Right-of-Way;

- permit a Food Service Establishment to use a portion of the Public Right-of-Way located directly in-front of an adjacent property with permission from the owner of such adjacent property;
- permit the city to remove materials that have not been removed outside of the Sidewalk Cafe Season and Streatery Season;
- 6) restrict music in Outdoor Dining Areas;

7) ensure an unobstructed path on the sidewalk with a minimum width of  $48^{\circ}$ ; and

8) increase the penalties for violation of the ordinance to \$250 per hour of
