## RESOLUTION NO. 4144 SENSE OF THE BOARD URGING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PERMIT MUNICIPALITIES TO INSTALL AND OPERATE SPEED CAMERAS NEAR SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, a national study found that two-thirds of drivers exceed the posted speed limit in school zones during the 30-minute period before and after school; and

WHEREAS, speeding cars near schools present an unreasonable risk to children walking to and from school; and

WHEREAS, Connecticut law currently does not permit the use of automated traffic enforcement such as speed cameras in school zones; and

WHEREAS, approximately 5,000 Stamford students walk to and from school each day; and

WHEREAS, automated school zone speed safety cameras would enhance the safety of students walking to and from school property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 31<sup>ST</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT it urges the Connecticut General Assembly to enact a statewide law permitting the use of automated speed safety cameras within a reasonable distance of school property.

This resolution was approved by a roll call vote of 27-7-2 at the Regular Meeting of the 31<sup>st</sup> Board of Representatives held on July 5, 2022.
