Mr. Madden stated that his office is still completing the report by doing site checks to ensure that the information in the report is accurate and also to ensure that the benefits are correct. He passed around an updated top 10 employer list: Stamford Hospital Systems, UBS Securities; Stamford City Government, Stamford Public Schools; RBS, Starwood Hotels; Deloitte, Gartner, General Re Insurance and Nestle Waters. He expects this to change in the next year because 2 companies anticipate expanding. The Economic Development Commission has not met since 2013 and there have been no reports approved since 2009. He would like to include the data from the last 4 years and also include the data as to what the State has reimbursed to the City. The Enterprise Zone also has not met in several years. His goal is to get both of these active again.

The Committee discussed the possibility of combining the Enterprise Zone and the Economic Development Commission. Many members of the business community do not know that the Enterprise Zone exists or the Enterprise Zone and Entertainment Zone
