The State & Commerce Committee met as indicated above. In attendance were Chair Buckman and Committee Member Reps. Fedeli, Heaphy, Pratt and Watkins. Absent or excused were Committee Member Reps. Quinones and Summerville. Also present were Rep. Reeder and Francis Pickering and Matt Weinstein of the Western Connecticut Regional Council of Governments.

Chair Buckman called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

Mr. Pickering reported that:

- The WestCOG was formed on January 1, 2015 and is the second largest COG in the State
- They have an office in Stamford and an office in Brookfield
- Their primary function in the past was regional planning, but the State legislature is focusing more on the delivery of regional services
- They are bringing on a new person to look at cost savings from regionalization
- Their main focus currently is transportation planning, including all modes of transportation in the region
 - They are looking at bus and shuttle services around the Stamford Transit Center
- They are developing a regional GIS which will be available online
- They will be seeking designation as an economic development district which will provide additional access to state and federal funds
- They are working on a natural disaster mitigation plan
- They currently have 13 employees

In response to questions from the Committee, Mr. Pickering stated that

- They have been providing input into the proposal to put in tolls
- They have been involved in the concept to widen I-95 between Stamford and Bridgeport
- Branch lines of the train need investment
- The proposed transit authority has reduced powers than originally contemplated and requires a MOU with any municipality; the WestCOG had voted in opposition to the authority; they would have a non-voting seat on it
- He will be glad to meet with the Committee again in the future
