Mr. Pensiero stated distributed an updated <u>City-specific project sheet</u>. Mr. Pensiero, Mr. Fernandez and Ms. Tamu reviewed Board of Ed and City technology projects:

- During the months of August and September, most of the City IT staff is dedicated to the Board of Education.
- The new Information Officer for the BOE, Christina Hefele has been very helpful in targeting appropriate technology to the curriculum.
- The City has identified the new equipment for the new school being constructed
- They have upgraded networks and wireless and are working on upgrades to the infrastructure
- They are looking at digital textbooks; have received a grant to bring the libraries more current; a shared library system with the Ferguson Library
- They are looking at migrating students to Office 365

- Powerschool has been used for the last 2 years
- Several City projects on the list have been completed, others have been delayed
- All traffic cameras are being recorded. Access is per the Ordinance and needs to be accessed at the Traffic Department
- Blue light technology will be placed in the parks
- They are hoping to have the purchase of beach sticker be available online
