Mr. Madden distributed the <u>attached handouts</u> and discussed the branding project with the Committee as follows:

- This is a project they have been working on for more than two years regarding the market and branding of the City and have been working with Stamford Partnership
- The City Seal represents the old city, and they want to both recognize the old City and where the City is going
- They did a campaign regarding the one word people felt would describe the City the results of which are shown on the handout; most of the responses were positive and used this for a design brief for the City and received over 700 entries for design entries for a logo for the City
- Based on the foregoing, they came down to the attached design
- They also looked for a tag line to replace "The City that Works"; they decided to build on the City being a center of innovation, over time and now with "Innovating Since 1641"
- This tagline is not based upon the one word people used to describe City, because those words didn't convey where the City is going; innovating was come up with by the group
