

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 231, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE V, SNOW EMERGENCIES TO PROVIDE FOR ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING DURING SNOW ACCUMULATION

This ordinance amends Chapter 231 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article V, of the Code of Ordinances by adding Sections 231-55 through 231-58 to require alternate side of the street parking on designated streets whenever two (2) or more inches of snow accumulate on the public streets of the City of Stamford. The ordinance provides that:

1) whenever two (2) or more inches of snow accumulates on the designated streets vehicles will be allowed to stand or park on the even-numbered side of the street between eight a.m. on even-numbered calendar days to eight a.m. of the following day; and on the odd-numbered side of the street between eight a.m. of an odd-numbered calendar day to eight a.m. of the following day;
2) the Mayor may extend or suspend the alternate side parking as neces-

any;
3) the Director of Operations must erect signs designating a street as an alternate side parking street, notify the Board of Representatives of any such designation and publish a list of all such designated streets in a newspaper and on the City website during October of each year; and 4) a parking ticket of \$25 will be issued to any vehicle violating the provisions of this article and such vehicle may be towed.
