SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 231 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE CLASS OF CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS

This ordinance amends Chapter 231 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article I, Section 231-8 of the Code of Ordinances to increase the class of certain park-

This ordinance amends Chapter 231 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article I, Section 231-8 of the Code of Ordinances to Increase the class of certain parking violations as follows:

(1) The following, which are currently Class II parking violations, shall be Class III parking violations:

(a) On a sidewalk.

(b) More than twelve (12) inches from a curb.

(c) Within twenty-five (25) feet of a street corner or intersection.

(d) Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign or traffic control signal located at the side of the roadway.

(e) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty (30) feet of the points on or at the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless the traffic authority has indicated a different length by signs or markings.

(f) Alongalde or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic.

(g) Wrong way on street against the flow of traffic.

(2) The following, which are currently Class III parking violations, shall be Class IV parking violations:

(a) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or with in a highway tunnel.

(b) Within an intersection.

(c) On a designated snow emergency route during a declared snow emergency.
