RESOLUTION NO. 3830 DESIGNATING A PARKING METER ZONE (AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 3802)

WHEREAS, Section 231-5 of the Code of the City of Stamford provides that the Board of Representatives shall designate parking meter spaces or zones within the City of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of August 25, 2016, the Transportation Committee of the Board of Representatives approved designating "Stillwater Avenue near Fairfield Avenue" as a parking meter zone, and Resolution Number 3802, approving such designation was approved by the Board of Representatives at its regular meeting on September 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, at the time the Committee discussed this item, the Committee was discussing designating the intersection of Stillwater Avenue at Virgil Street as a parking meter zone rather than Stillwater Avenue near Fairfield Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Committee of the Board of Representatives considered the matter of removing the designation of Stillwater Avenue near Fairfield Avenue as a parking meter zone and designating the intersection of Stillwater Avenue at Virgil Street at its January 26, 2017 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives approved removing the designation of Stillwater Avenue near Fairfield Avenue as a parking meter zone the designation of the below-listed locations as a parking meter zone at its February 6, 2017 regular board meeting.


