**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE**  
**AMENDING §231-15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**  
**VIOLETION OF PEDESTRIAN RIGHT OF WAY**

This ordinance amends Section 231-15 of the Code of Ordinances to include a \$100 fine, enforceable by the civil citation process, for any person 1) violating the prohibition against crossing at an intersection against a red or "Stop" signal or a "Don't Walk" signal, or crossing at any place not a marked or unmarked crosswalk; or 2) failing to keep to the right while walking on a sidewalk or obstructing a crossing or an entrance to a building. The ordinance further amends Section 231-15 to include a \$250 fine for any motorist who 1) fails to yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian in a crosswalk in accordance with the requirements of state law or in a marked or unmarked crosswalk; or 2) overtakes and passes a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk to permit a pedestrian to cross the roadway.
