**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE  
AMENDING SECTION 231, ARTICLE I, SECTIONS 6, 7 AND 8,  
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO  
PROVIDE FOR NEW FINES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS**

This ordinance amends Sections 231-6, 231-7 and 231-8 of the Code of Ordinances to 1) make it a Class II violation to park a vehicle on any city street if the last registered owner of the vehicle or license plate owes delinquent parking fines in a total of \$250.00 or more, or has three or more delinquent parking citations that are otherwise unsettled and uncontested and to permit the removal of such vehicle by towing or otherwise; 2) require that parking violation fines be paid within 15 days; 3) provide for the doubling of fines not paid within 15 days and tripling of fines not paid within 30 days, such penalty not to exceed \$250; and 4) provide for the assessment of a replacement fee of \$500 and a \$250 fine to be assessed against any person who removes a vehicle which has been immobilized by a self-releasing immobilization device or removes such device.

This document is prepared for the benefit of the public, solely for purposes of information, summarization and explanation. This document does not represent the intent of the legislative body of the City of Stamford for any purpose.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 231, ARTICLE VII, TOWING  
FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR TOWING  
AND BOOTING FEES**

This ordinance amends Section 231-68 of the Code of Ordinances as follows: 1) when a vehicle is towed in the City of Stamford, the tower shall collect from the owner an administrative fee of \$50 before the vehicle is released to its owner; 2) when a vehicle is booted in the City of Stamford, the City or the booting company shall collect from the owner of said vehicle a booting charge equal to the cost of the charge incurred by the city from any company providing such service, but not more than \$200, plus an administrative fee of 50 before the vehicle is released to the owner; and 3) if the owner of a booted car fails to pay the required charges and fines within 24 hours, the City may remove the boot and tow the vehicle and the owner shall be responsible for both the applicable booting and towing fees.
