

Resolution Opposing Tolls in Connecticut

Whereas the Governor and many members of the State Legislature have signaled support for the placement of tolls on Connecticut's major roadways;

Whereas many of the residents of Stamford use these roadways each day for work, family obligations and pleasure and spend a significant amount of time on these traffic congested roads;

Whereas the implementation of tolls will result in a significant amount of traffic on Stamford's roads as drivers attempt to avoid the cost burden;

Whereas the residents of Connecticut already pay more in taxes and fees than most residents in other states around the country;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Representative of the City of Stamford is opposed to the imposition of tolls on its residents and urges its elected representatives in the State Legislature to oppose any measure that would impose tolls on our constituents.
