## RESOLUTION NO. 4023 DESIGNATING PARKING METER ZONES

**WHEREAS**, Section 231-5 of the Code of the City of Stamford provides that the Board of Representatives shall designate parking meter spaces or zones within the City of Stamford; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Committee of the Board of Representatives considered the matter of designating the below-listed locations as parking meter zones at its November 21, 2019 meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Representatives approved the designation of the below-listed locations as parking meter zones at its December 3, 2019 regular board meeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives, pursuant to Section 231-5 of the Code of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the following locations as parking meter zones.

1. Clinton Avenue – both sides of the road from Tresser Boulevard to Richmond Hill Avenue
2. Division Street – both sides of the road from Clinton Avenue to Washington Boulevard
3. Pacific Street – south side of the road from Belden Street approximately 375 feet to the west to Residential Parking Program Zone 39.
4. Washington Boulevard – both sides of the road from Atlantic Street to Pacific Street

This Resolution is effective upon enactment.


