Re: Proposed Ordinance Amendment

Attached please find draft changes to Ordinance Sections 231-6 and 231.44 for the Board's review and approval.

The amendments intend to accomplish the following:

- 1. Update the ordinance to provide more protection for pedestrians by requiring vehicles to park at least 25' from all crosswalks – not just crosswalks located at intersections. Further, the penalty for this infraction increases to a Class III violation from a Class II.
- 2. Increase the infraction from Class II to Class III for those who park anywhere official signs prohibit stopping or parking
- 3. Increase the infraction from Class II to Class IV for violating residential parking permit area regulations.

The change to Section 231.44 increases the fine from \$90 to \$120 for the following:

- 1. Providing false information to the Director of Operations in applications for permits.
- 2. Using parking permits on vehicles for which the permit was not issued.
- 3. Allowing nonresidents to use residential parking visitor permits for any other purpose than visiting the residential parking permit holder
- 4. Creating false/counterfeit parking permits and/or knowingly use such counterfeit permit.
- 5. Parking in a residential parking permit area without a permit.
