SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 231, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE IV, TRUCK PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS, SECTION 231-46, RESTRICTED PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS

This Ordinance amends Chapter 231, Vehicles And Traffic, Article IV, Truck Parking On Residential Streets, to repeal and replace Section 231-46, Restricted Parking On Residential Streets regulating the parking of large motorized and non-motorized vehicles on streets located in residentia motorized and non-motorized vehicles on streets located in residential zones by reducing the current weight restriction(s) and imposing additional restrictions (such as weight and height) while also considering the plate types of those vehicles. Specifically, the ordinance prohibits vehicles bearing types of number plates specified on Schedule A and which have any one of several specified characteristics, including: (1) height in excess of 8 feet; (2) length in excess of 20 feet, (3) width in excess of 7 feet (excluding mirror); (4) more than 4 wheels in contact with the ground; (5) gross vehicle weight or gross combination weight rating in excess of 12,000 pounds; or (6) capacity in excess of 3/4 tons, which is not used solely by the occupants of a premises and has been prohibited by the City of Stamford Zoning Regulations from parking on or being caraged on of Stamford Zoning Regulations from parking on or being garaged on private residential property, from parking on residential streets between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. or for longer than 2 hours in any 24
