Subject: Speed Camera Update

Good afternoon everyone,

You may have read or heard about speed cameras lately either through the news or through the Steering Committee Agenda.

I just wanted to provide some background and clarification on the item that will be before the Transportation Committee this month.

Recently passed by the Board and Finance, and slated to be reviewed by the Board of Reps is a contract with Sitestream LLC for the operation and service of our Automated Traffic Enforcement Safety Devices commonly known as speed cameras.

The 31st Board passed the enabling ordinance and approved 14 locations for speed cameras. The Transportation Committee was the BOR committee that handled speed cameras.

What will be before the Committee this month will be a contract for the vendor to operate the cameras since the estimated cost is over \$100,000 and per the City Charter, the BOR has to approve all contracts in excess of that sum. The item is not to approve any locations of new cameras or modify the ordinance.

I plan on giving a brief overview of our speed camera program during the meeting as background. You can also learn more about our program by visiting the City's webpage here:
