The Committee discussed the revised draft ordinance submitted by Director Fountain. Ms. Fountain stated that by State Public Health code, the Department of Health ensures testing is done before they sign off for approval. Ms. Fountain added that knowing the public health risks of contaminants such as uranium and pesticides, State Code allows her to add these to the list for testing.

The committee discussed adding section 5 stating that if contractors chose to use the Stamford Department of Health for the water quality test, the provisions of Chapter 143 section 14 would also apply to testing on newly dug wells. Chair Nabel suggested asking Ms. Rosenson to draft that paragraph.

A motion was made to amend section 143-15 to add Section 5. Said motion was seconded and approved 4-0-0.

A motion to approve this item for publication as amended was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 4-0-0

Chair Nabel adjourned the meeting at 6:45 p.m.
