RESOLUTION NO. 3547 CREATION OF THE 18TH CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section C1-40-5 of the City of Stamford Charter provides that there shall be a mandatory review of all of the provisions and amendments of the City Charter at ten-year intervals by a Charter Revision Commission appointed in accordance with the provisions of Home Rule Law; and

WHEREAS, the last Charter review became effective on December 3, 2012; and

WHEREAS, section C1-40-5 provides for the appointment "interim Charter Review Commissions" at the discretion of the Board of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to start the Charter Review process at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 28TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:


1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section C1-40-5 of the City Charter, and Chapter 99 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the City of Stamford shall begin the process to review and revise its Charter.

This resolution shall take effect upon its enactment.
