## RESOLUTION NO. 3548 CONCERNING APPOINTMENT OF THE 18<sup>th</sup> INTERIM CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION MEMBERS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C1-40-5 of the City of Stamford Charter, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-188 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the Board of representatives has initiated the process of charter revision; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-190(a) of said General Statutes provides that within thirty days of such action, the appointment authority shall by resolution appoint a commission consisting of not fewer than five nor more than fifteen electors, not more than one-third of whom may hold any other public office in the municipality and not more than a bare majority of whom may hold any other public office in the municipality and not more than a bare majority of whom shall be members of any one political party; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has completed its process of interviewing and selecting people to serve on the 18<sup>th</sup> Charter Review Commission.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 28<sup>th</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 7-190 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford hereby appoints the 18<sup>th</sup> Charter Revision Commission.
- 2. The 18<sup>th</sup> Charter Revision Commission shall be composed of seven (7) members, not more than a bare majority being members of any one political party and not more than one-third holding any form of public office in the City.

3. The members of the 18<sup>th</sup> Charter Revision Commission shall be the following:

4. The 18<sup>th</sup> Charter Revision Commission shall terminate upon acceptance or rejection of its final report by the Board of Representatives.
