For the last year, public and private stakeholders, including Veterans groups, have worked together to envision and plan for a new design for Veterans Memorial Park. We envision that the park's new design will encompass many objectives: to celebrate and honor Veterans who served our country in a more comprehensive way; to serve as a public meeting place; to become an entryway to the mall and offices; to become a venue for community-oriented events; to be a primary link for east-west connection through the downtown; and to continue to serve as an integral hub for bus travel.
