Roll call was taken with the result: 21 present, 19 absent, as indicated on the attached attendance sheet.

Louise T. Seeley, 1st District, NOVED the resolution be adouted, seconded by Patrick Scarella, 3rd District, and CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Stearns Woodman, 7th District, MOVED the meeting be adjourned, seconded, and CARRIED. The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
